

Bylaw

ORGANIZATION MEETING

The board shall organize annually at a regular meeting held not later than 8 p.m. on a day appointed by statute. If the organization meeting cannot take place on that day because of lack of a quorum or for any other reason, the meeting shall be held within three days thereafter.

The organization meeting shall be called to order by the board secretary, who shall act as temporary chairperson. The board shall proceed to the election of a president who shall immediately become chairperson; the board shall then elect a vice president. A majority vote of the members of the board present and voting shall be necessary for election.

At the organization meeting, the board shall appoint those officials determined by law and shall also:

- A. Designate a day, place and time for regular meetings;
- B. Readopt the existing bylaws and policies for its own operation and the operation of the school system;
- C. Address committee assignments for the coming year;
- D. Appoint a delegate to the New Jersey School Boards Association and the Burlington County School Boards Association;
- E. Approve parliamentary procedures;
- F. Approve curriculum;
- G. Approve textbooks;
- H. Adoption of the Code of Ethics;
- I. Conduct other regular business scheduled on the agenda.
