

PUPIL VEHICLES
STUDENT USE OF BICYCLES AND MOTOR VEHICLES

The board regards the use of bicycles for travel to and from school by pupils as an assumption of responsibility on the part of those pupils, a responsibility in the care of property, in the observation of safety rules and in the display of courtesy and consideration toward others.

The board will permit the use of bicycles by students provided:

- A. Bicycles must be parked in the racks which are provided on the school grounds. A locking device should be used by each pupil.
- B. Bicycles may not be ridden on the school grounds at any time.
- C. Students who ride bicycles to and from school must wear approved bicycle helmets.
- D. All rules for bicycle safety must be followed.
- E. Valid registration and inspection.

The board will not permit the use of mini-bikes, motorcycles, or mopeds.

The board will not be responsible for bicycles which are lost, stolen or damaged.
