

SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCES NOTIFICATION

It shall be the policy of the Board of Education, pursuant to the Worker and Community Right to Know Act, N.J.S.A. 34:5A-3 et seq., to publish notice annually to all members of the school community of any construction, installation, renovation or other activities involving the use of any known hazardous substances in or on the school campus. Such notice shall be published annually and prominently posted on the district bulletin board at any such time throughout the year when such materials are to be used. The notice shall state the activity to be conducted and the hazardous substances to be used and shall be posted at least two days prior to any activity to be performed except where an emergency condition prevents the two-day notice in which case the notice shall be posted as soon as practicable. Hazardous substance fact sheets shall be maintained on site as required and open to public inspection when requested.
