

RESIGNATION/REMOVAL FROM OFFICE

Whenever a member ceases to be a bona fide resident of the district, his/her membership shall cease immediately. The removal of a member who resigns shall become effective upon the presentation of the resignation to the board in a regular meeting.

Any member who fails to attend three consecutive meetings of the board without good cause may be removed from office on the affirmative vote of a majority of the members of the board present and voting, provided that the action shall have been proposed at the preceding meeting of the board and provided that notice of the action has been given to the absent member in advance of the meeting for which such action has been proposed.
