Dear Parents/Guardians:

Enclosed is the June 2019 Exam Schedule. Exams will be given June 18 through June 25. Due to the fact that exams begin on June 18, the last day of classes will be Monday, June 17. The exam/bus schedule is listed at the end of this letter and is also located on the bottom of the Exam Schedule.

Please note that if your child has no exam scheduled for any particular day, he/she should not report to school. Book bags and all electronic devices including cell phones, iPods, etc. will not be permitted in exam rooms. Students may store these items in their lockers during testing. It will be your child's responsibility to retrieve these items upon completion of exams. Violation of this rule can have serious consequences.

Laptops issued by the District to the 9th grade students will be collected on June 21st when students arrive for their final exam in English. Laptops will be updated and reissued to the students in September.

Below you will find information concerning summer school for Nyack students in grades 9 through 12. We are sending this information to everyone, but recognize that most of you will not need to act on these matters.

- **Location:** Summer school will be held at Fieldstone Secondary School (100 Fieldstone Drive, Thiells, NY). All Nyack students are required to attend summer school at this location. Busing will be provided.
- **Eligibility:** Summer school is required for students who need to pass courses for promotion and/or to meet graduation requirements. To be eligible to attend summer school courses, a student must have a final average between 55 and 64. Students who receive a final average lower than 55 are not eligible and will be rescheduled for the course. Students may take a maximum of two courses in summer school.
The above restrictions are waived for seniors who would be eligible to graduate in August.
- **Registration:** ***Please do not wait for notification by mail regarding failures.*** Your child should register for summer school as soon as he/she knows of, or is notified of, any failures. The summer session starts Tuesday, July 9 and ends on Monday, August 12. If your child fails one or more subjects, he/she must register by speaking with his/her counselor. 
After July 5, if your child needs to register for a **Regents Exam only (not a course)**, they must register for the exam directly at Fieldstone (but no later than Friday, July 19, 11:30 AM).

Rockland BOCES also offers an optional *Regents Review Course* for the August Regents for a fee of \$200. If interested, students must register for this review course directly at Fieldstone no later than July 19, 11:30 AM.

Although information will be mailed to you if your child receives a failing grade in one or more courses in June, your child should register as soon as possible.
