

NHRS WALL OF FAME CRITERIA AND NOMINATION PROCESS

1. **NOMINEES MUST:**

- Be New Rochelle High School graduates; however, they need not reside in New Rochelle.
- Have graduated at least ten years before the year of nomination.
- Model high standards of excellence in personal and professional life.
- Have succeeded as local, regional or international levels in any appropriate areas of endeavor, including academia and education, arts, business, media, public service, medicine, military, sports, etc.
- Be or have been outstanding contributors to volunteer service or to their local community.

2. **NOMINATION PROCESS:**

- **All nominations** must be submitted via the nomination Google form. [CLICK HERE](#) to access the nomination Google form. All nominations must be submitted by May 31, 2020.
- If a nominee is not selected to the Wall of Fame in a particular year, that nominee will be automatically reconsidered for the following three years.
- Posthumous nominations are accepted, provided the alumnus/a fulfilled the criteria during his/her lifetime.

Please note that nominees' identities will be held in confidence by the Wall of Fame committee until posted on our website at the beginning of each school year.

In July of each year:

Nominators will receive a letter notifying them whether or not their candidate has been selected by the committee to be inducted into the Wall of Fame.

Alumni selected will also receive a congratulatory letter from our Principal with instructions regarding submission of photo for the Wall and information for the plaque. Both nominators and inductees will be invited to the induction ceremony. Details on date and time of induction ceremony will be announced on our website in by the end of October.

Note: The Wall of Fame committee can only consider completed applications.
