Hello Tenth, Eleventh and Twelfth Grade Students, Parents, and Guardians,

Welcome back to New Rochelle High School! I hope everyone is doing well and staying safe. I know the pandemic has impacted our community in many ways causing anxiety over the various uncertainties we are now facing in our lives. As summer comes to a close we are about to start a school year in a manner which is new to all of us. Despite the challenges we are all facing, our administration, secretaries, faculty and staff have been hard at work this summer preparing to make this upcoming school year a great one!

I am returning this year to New Rochelle HS as Interim Principal after a three-year absence. I retired in 2017 after thirty years as the Social Studies Department Chair for the Secondary Schools. Also, returning as Assistant Principal, after a year at Albert Leonard MS, is Camille Edwards-Thomas. We are joined by Interim Assistant Principal Rachel Cornelius. We look forward to working with a highly qualified and dedicated staff who are eager to provide you with a robust and enriching educational experience.

During this time of social distancing we want to ensure that each of our high school students continues to have access to high-quality curriculum and assignments. We plan to deliver instruction through a virtual learning environment, and we need your support to ensure the success of our efforts! Please take a moment to review our plan below and talk with your children about their responsibilities during this time.

This form needs to be filled out by every student and their parent/guardian regardless of whether they have a personal device or a device borrowed from the school district at home.

During the week of September 8, asynchronous modules will be posted on your NRHS CLASS Google Classroom **CLASS CODE:**

Students are expected to complete these during the week. Completion of these modules will serve as your attendance each day. Beginning on Monday, September 14, the regular eight-period day (the schedule is on a separate page) will begin. Teachers will send their Google-classroom codes before then. Instruction will be synchronous through either Zoom or Google-Meet. Teachers will be available through email or posted "office hours." The current reentry plan has students returning to school in person utilizing a hybrid model with a three-day rotation in October. You will receive an email with more specific information in a few weeks. In the meantime, students should check the high school website regularly for important updates.

On September 8th-10th we ask that you return any textbooks that you still have at home. Please return your items according to the schedule below on the day your grade is designated to come in.
