2020/21 AP STUDIO ART APPLICATION

DUE : Wednesday 27 February 2020 (The Wednesday after we return from Winter Break)

The **Advanced Placement Studio Art** course at NRHS is a college level studio experience designed to challenge highly motivated art students. The course involves assembling a portfolio and submitting it to the College Board in early May for an evaluation. A student who receives a high score may receive college credit or advanced standing in college, depending on the policy of the school they attend.

AP Studio Art requires a serious investment of **time** and **effort**. Unlike most art courses, **most** of the work is done during **free time** or **at home**, because class time is often devoted to critiques and discussions. The course is especially helpful to students interested in applying to art schools or studying art in college, but anybody who has taken 'Studio Art', elective Art classes, or who has a strong drawing or sculpture background is eligible to apply.

The fee charged by the College Board for evaluating portfolios is approximately \$93.00. A substantial reduction is available, thus no student should decide against taking the course for monetary reasons.

Admission to A.P. Studio Art is based on a portfolio review by all of the Art Department staff. Interested students should submit the required portfolio (pg. 2) to your current Art instructor, Ms. Schomber or to Mr. Seaboldt, no later than **3:00 pm Wednesday 26 February 2020.**

No late portfolios will be accepted.

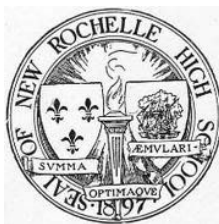

AP Studio Art Application Portfolio Requirements

- All portfolios are due to art instructors by **3:00 pm Wednesday 26 February 2020**.
- **No late portfolios will be accepted.**
- Any questions regarding this portfolio, please ask your current art teacher, Ms. Schomber or Mr. Seaboldt.
- **Applicant portfolios must contain all 3 of the below**

#1 CHOICE PIECE: Any Artwork that Shows off Your Skills.

This may be an artwork previously created in an art class or newly created for this application.

Grading will be based upon skill, proficiency, and competency in:

- The use of Media
- The use of Design and Composition
- The depiction of the imagery

This artwork may be in any size, 2-D, 3-D, and in any media, [ceramic, digital, sculpture, painting, drawing, etc.]

#2 SAME DIFFERENCE: An Investigation of an Idea/concept

A series of 3 artworks that are better together because they share an idea or a concept. Same message in 3 different languages. 3 ways of saying the same thing, each better than the other, Same Difference, but better.

If you are applying for 3-D they must be 3-dimensional, if you are applying for 2-d/drawing or painting they must be a 2-dimensional media.

This should be an artwork that is newly created for this application.

Grading will be based upon how creative, inventive and imaginative:

- The use of Media is
- The use of design and composition is
- The depiction of the imagery is

#3 ESSAY: Exactly 100 Typed Words

EXACTLY 100 words (**TYPED**) artist statement about your artwork in #2 SAME DIFFERENCE

Grading will be based on how your writing explains:

- WHY: the concept behind SAME DIFFERENCE
- WHAT: your use of media in SAME DIFFERENCE
- HOW: your process of SAME DIFFERENCE

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
