1. Go to **google.com** and click sign in. Enter your username. (If you are having difficulty with your username, please email Mr. Silviotti for help at [msilviotti@nredlearn.org](mailto:msilviotti@nredlearn.org))
2. Click Next.
3. Enter your password. (If you forgot your password you can email Mr. Silviotti for help at [msilviotti@nredlearn.org](mailto:msilviotti@nredlearn.org). He will send you a temporary password.)
4. Click Next.
