MISSING NYS ELA & MATH TEST SCORES & CORE SUBJECT GRADES:

- NYS APPLICANTS – whose NYS ELA or Math exam scores and/or 4th grade core subject scores are not available, an email will be sent to the sending middle school’s guidance counselor to acquire updated information. If the State tests and/or any of the core subject grades are still missing, the most recent score(s) available will be used to make a ranking determination.
- PRIVATE/PAROCHIAL APPLICANTS/OUT-OF-STATE/INTERNATIONAL APPLICANTS – who do not have NY State standardized test scores will be considered if they have nationally normalized standardized examination scores, or PS 126 will convert other testing scores for non-NY State Exams where possible. In addition, PS 126 will contact the applicant’s current/previous school to obtain documentation (e.g. transcripts, report cards, etc.) to determine appropriate corresponding scores in order to provide the student with a rank.

Internal Assessment
