Dear Parents and Guardians,

Through our most recent New York State Integration Plan we have the opportunity to work with NYU Metro Center to capture the lived experiences of district students and families by exploring the interconnectedness of race, power and privilege. Students will share how they might improve school climate for racially, culturally, and linguistically diverse students. Students reflect on key areas of their school climate that might be impacted by cross-racial, cross-ethnic, and cross-cultural dynamics. The students and families will make recommendations for improving climate district-wide.

NYU Equity Coaches will lead this work and engage cohorts of students in a dialogue around the way they feel their intersectional identities (race, ethnicity, language, culture, gender, sexual orientation, religion, (dis)ability, and socioeconomic status) are welcomed, honored, responded to, centered and sustained in their schools. They will draft examples of interactions they either witnessed or experienced themselves that can be used as case studies with adult stakeholders working to promote culturally responsive and sustaining practices in the classroom and beyond. These sessions will be documented through video and audio clips and participants will need required permissions.
