Selection Procedure

Process

1. Student submits a completed application to their adviser.
2. The Faculty Council review all applications.
3. Students are selected based on the national standards set forth by NHS.

Appeal Process

Because NHS encourages strong leadership and character students themselves are expected to seek an appeal themselves.

Process

1. If a student is not selected for membership in NHS they may submit a formal appeal in writing within five business days of the postmarked date on the rejection letter to be submitted to the NHS adviser.
2. The appeal should be in the form a letter. This letter should describe how the standard(s) the non-selection letter listed as reasons for non-selection are met. If there is new information that was not included in the original application proper documentation is required as outlined in the original application.
3. Once received, the adviser will resubmit the application to the faculty council for a second review with the appeal letter included.
4. The student will be informed of the council's decision within five business days of the receipt of the appeal letter. If further action is needed a meeting with the principal will be scheduled.
