## *Conflict and Clashes of Ideologies that Changed the World*

By examining and discussing primary and secondary sources students will study why and how nations proceeded to extend their power and influence over other peoples; why and how conquered peoples struggled, or not, against the exploitation, genocide and settlement, and the political, cultural and economic dominance visited upon them; what the consequences and repercussions were of the conflicts and the clashes of ideologies in the twentieth century; and how all of it changed the world. And how these events connect to U.S. history and affected the U.S. internally and externally.

Students will practice writing persuasively and engage in group simulations and discussions.

Topics will include: a review of *Colonialism*, and an in-depth study of the two *World Wars* and the *Cold War*.
