**Late Fees and Penalties:** Payment received after January 7<sup>th</sup> is subject to late fees. Students who miss the January 7, 2019 deadline will NOT BE GUARANTEED preferred sweatshirt and t-shirt sizes. **If you do not pay your dues by January 7, 2019, then the amount increases according to the following schedule:**

- If you pay between January 8 and March 9, the fee is \$5 (new total \$180)
- If you pay between March 10 and May 10, the fee is \$10 (new total is \$185)
- If you pay in after May 11, the fee is \$15 (new total is \$190)

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## Participation in Senior Activities

Senior year is an exciting time for both students and parents. While there are many activities planned during the course of the year, the priority of Bayside High School has always been the safety of the students. In order to ensure that the activities that are planned are safe and enjoyable for everyone, the following guidelines have been established. They apply to both current and past students.

- (1) Any student who has had a **superintendent's suspension** at **ANY** point during their time at Bayside High School will be **banned** from senior activities such as the senior trip and/or the senior prom.
- (2) Any student who has an extensive disciplinary record during their time at Bayside High School will be **banned** from senior activities such as the senior trip and/or the senior prom.
- (3) Any student that has **any type of suspension** during their *SENIOR* year will be **banned** from senior activities such as the senior trip and/or the senior prom.

With respect to participation in senior events, we remind you that they are privileges and are reserved for students who have achieved senior status. Our priority is to make sure that the students have met all requirements for graduation and, in order to do so, the following guidelines have been established:

- (1) Any student who lacks the necessary credits to graduate in June 2018 cannot participate in the June graduation ceremonies, even if he/she is expected to obtain those credits over the summer of 2018.
- (2) **Any senior who is on Academic Probation for any reason**, including, but not limited to, students who fail a class in any one marking period (even if the class is not required for graduation or absent from a scheduled Regents exam), **will not be permitted to participate in any senior activity-** including, but not limited to, the senior trip and/or senior prom.
- (3) At least a Ninety (90) percent attendance record is required to participate in senior activities.
