# Roadrunner Paintball Rental /Participation Agreement

Read carefully before signing

1. I accept for use "as is" the equipment rented by Roadrunner Paintball (marker, goggles and Camo-suits), and accept full responsibility for the care of the equipment while it is in my possession.
2. I will be responsible for the replacement at full rental value of any equipment rented, if not returned to Roadrunner Paintball.
3. Roadrunner paintball conducts paintball games and other games using among other things, marking pellets propelled co2 powered markers. I understand that this activity and transportation to and from it can be hazardous and involve risks that could result in personal injury, including eye injury or even death as well as damage to or loss of participant. This is conducted in variable terrain, which can include rocks, trees, steep inclines, streams, foxholes or other features, which can cause accident or harm to others or myself.
4. I clearly understand the requirement and necessity that eye goggles provided by Roadrunner Paintball/ Pinegrove Resort must be worn and kept firmly on the face at all times when and/or near the playing field. These risks have been explained to and I recognize, accept and assume them.
