Policy Statement:

3. Offer family engagement activities throughout the year. 4. Parents will be encouraged to visit in classrooms and flex groups anytime during the school year.
5. Provide materials to assist parents in supporting their child's education at home.
6. Provide parents with information about their student's progress during parent-teacher conferences.
7. Make information available whenever possible in a format and language that parents can understand.
8. Involve parents in planning, reviewing, and improving School Name's Title I program including the parental involvement policy, home-school compact, and family engagement activities.
