RE: *PSSA – Science Assessment*

The students in grade four at McCullough Elementary School and in the Penn-Trafford School District will be administered the PSSA – Science statewide assessment during the week of April 23, 2018. The PSSA is a state standardized assessment for science for all fourth grade students in Pennsylvania.

Below are a few important items to review for the testing dates:

1. It is very important that your child be present at school on each of the testing days.
2. Please be sure that your child arrives to school on time each of the testing days.
3. Avoid scheduling appointments that would pull your child out of school during the testing week.
4. Your child needs to be well rested for each day of testing. Be sure that he/she receives a good night of sleep.
5. See that your child eats a healthy breakfast each morning of the PSSA. This way, your child will be ready to do his/her best work on the test.
