Welcome to the Penn-Trafford School District!

*Thank you for registering your child for Kindergarten for the 2019-2020 school year. Entering Kindergarten is an exciting time for both you and your child! Our district has planned some **FUN** activities and events that will assist you and your child in the transition to Kindergarten.*

With your registration, you have "booked" your child a trip on the PT Transition Train! Enclosed you will find a **magnet** that reminds you to "Hop Aboard" the various transition activities the district offers, along with listing the dates of these important events:

First Stop: Kindergarten Kick Off Night on Wednesday, April 3rd, 2019. This event takes place in each individual elementary school often in different sessions based on last name. More detailed information will be mailed in March. Students must plan to attend this evening! Parents will need to sign up for a screening time with the Principals, receive a 2019-20 school calendar, and visit booths from local organizations where they can meet school support staff, local community organizations, and PTO representatives. Your child will be able to see a Kindergarten classroom, meet some teachers, and receive a backpack with supplies. Incoming Kindergarten students will participate in activities while you attend presentations containing helpful parental information. The evening will conclude with a ride on a school bus!

Second Stop: Kindergarten Screening, May 13th and 14th, 2019. A member of our Kindergarten staff will give your child the district Kindergarten Screening Assessment. The teacher will discuss the results with you and let you know if your child qualifies for additional assistance at our Summer Learning Camp. You will also be able to meet with the school nurse to turn in your health forms, birth certificate, and discuss your child's health needs for the school year.

Third Stop: Kindergarten Open House, EITHER August 19 OR 20, (Differs by Elementary School). You will accompany your child to school for a visit and orientation with your child's Kindergarten teacher. Your child will be able to complete an activity, while the parents meet with the teacher and receive other helpful information.

In March, you will receive a packet of materials to further guide you through the enrollment process. We look forward to helping you and your child with a very positive transition experience! Should you have any questions, please feel free to contact our staff at your home elementary school.
