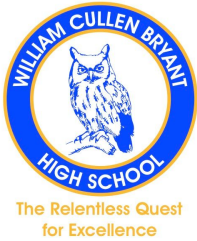

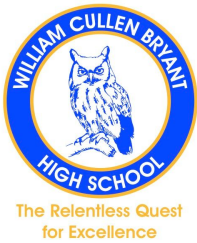
Travel Advisory:
