Dear Parents/Guardians

A reminder on Mr. DeBellis' Blackboard Connect, that on Wednesday, June 3 and Thursday, June 4, from 9 am - 12 pm, THS will distribute locker belongings; will return any medications and/or medical equipment. Seniors are asked to return Chromebooks and textbooks if they do not need for classes or their internships

Please take a few moments to review the procedures for the distribution of the aforementioned items. Please be sure to wear a face covering when picking-up the items and display the student's Last Name on a sign in the front windshield.

- To ensure the health and safety of all families and staff, all health recommendations and guidelines will be followed, including social distancing. We ask for families to wear face masks when picking-up items. Our staff will also be wearing face masks and gloves.
- We ask that you please be patient so that we can distribute locker belongings in a safe and orderly manner. Please place a sign in the front window displaying the student's last name. This will assist the staff with retrieving the locker items in an efficient manner.
- Cars will assemble on Siwanoy Blvd., facing West (toward Cottle), and remain on the right side of the road closest to the MS/HS. Please be respectful of any neighbor's driveway and obey engine idling laws.
- Cars will be directed by staff to enter the school parking lot, up to 3 cars at a time.
- A staff member will then retrieve your student/s belongings and either place them on a table next to the car or place them in the car's trunk, whichever the family prefers. Cars will then exit the parking lot onto Middle Road.
- There will be a table set-up in the parking lot for the return of medications/medical equipment. The district nurse will be at the table to return these items and to collect a signature from the parent/guardian. Please have identification if you need to pick up medications.
- Any items not retrieved by families will be discarded, unless other arrangements have been made.
