In addition, to help prepare our students for the SAT and/or ACT exam, the THS Math Department has made available the use of an online review course, Method Test Prep. This program is **available on July 6th** and through the student's Castle Learning account. Method Test Prep consists of a predefined, 18-20 week review course for both Math and English sections as well as specific topic review. *This is voluntary and we strongly recommend students take advantage of this online resource provided by the district.*
