Dear Parents/Guardians:

As you are aware, the district will be closing starting tomorrow, March 12 for two weeks. We will reopen on Thursday, March 26. This is the directive of Governor Cuomo and his stabilizing of a one-mile containment zone around the New Rochelle area. The containment zone is to clean facilities including schools and not applied to individuals and other daily activities.

With the coronavirus announcement, the teachers immediately started to implement the e-learning process they had been working on and completed last week in the event we would face an extended closing. You can be assured that while we are out of the building, our faculty will be posting assignments, videos, notes and assessments via Google Classroom.

Students should be checking daily for updates from each teacher. Teachers and myself will be available via email to answer any questions. Technology, blended learning and Google Classroom are already embedded in our daily instruction practices. So, access to learning should not be an issue for your student. Administration and teachers will be available to assist should an issue arise.

Today, teachers met with their classes with regards to the e-learning expectations. With regents and AP exams in the near future, please follow up with your student to assure they are fully engaged the next two weeks and they understand that the educational process at THS is continuing.

On that note, the portal is open for the third marking period progress reports as of this afternoon. Your child's teachers will be grading assessments. You are welcome to view as you normally would.
