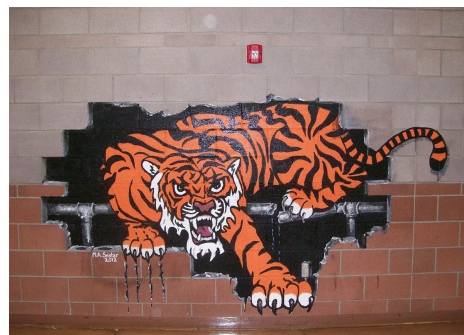
From the librarian...

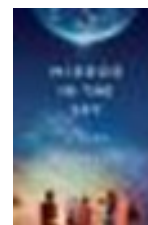

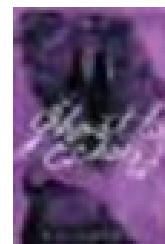

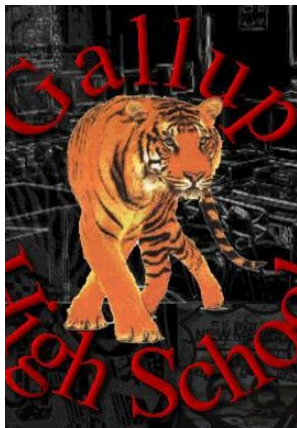

1st Place Prize: GHS Library thermal cup

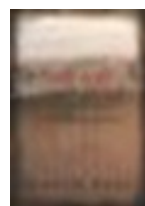
2nd Place: “Read” pen

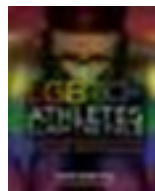

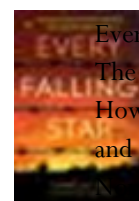
