Student mastery of the basic math skills is as important to success in your future mathematical procedures and reasoning as learning the alphabet is to reading and writing.

Over the summer, you will need to practice addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. The follow are explanations and examples of what we expect students to review and know coming into the  $4^{th}$  grade:

#1 You should memorize and master their multiplication tables, up to 12 example:  $12 \times 1 = 12$  up to  $12 \times 12 = 144$ 

\*\*\*Practice everyday and use flash cards to extra help.

#2 You will also need to practice subtraction with the zeros, and borrowing, with multi-digit numbers. Example: 500 - 321 = 382 - 127 =

#3 Simple division facts. Fact families.

4x6 = 24, so 24/4 = 6 and 24/6 = 4
