School Survey

A few last minute reminders, the Chancellor has extended the completion of the School Survey until June 30th . The deadline to complete the Return to School 2020 Survey has been extended to **June 30**, to ensure that more students and families are able to participate. As a reminder, this survey was created to gather feedback from students and families about the most important considerations for their return to school in the fall. All students in grades 6–12, and parents/guardians of students in grades 3K–12 are invited to participate in this anonymous online survey. To capture feedback from as many voices as possible, principals should continue to use their established means of communication to ensure that families and students are aware of the survey and know how to access it. In addition, your parent coordinators should continue to promote the survey to families. Please note that BCO academic policy performance and assessment leads (APPAs) are available to support schools with the resolution of technical issues in
