Opt In Period

Please be reminded of the Opt In period for Blended Learning. The process outlined below will be the only opt-in window for families this school year, through the last day of the 2020-2021 school year. We believe that this best meets the needs of students, families, teachers, and school leaders as we establish strong routines and structures for learning. As such, the process for blended learning opt-in is as follows:

Monday, November 2 – Sunday, November 15: Blended Learning Opt-In Window for Families

- Families requesting to change from 100% remote to blended learning should complete and submit the [Learning Preference survey](#) during this window.
- Schools will be able to review individual students' updated learning preference on a rolling basis during this window.
- During this time, Superintendents, Executive Superintendents and Central DOE will begin supporting schools to ensure as many students as possible are

accommodated for blended learning.
