School Rules

1. Students will follow directions and be respectful of all adults on our school.
2. Our school maintains a zero tolerance policy towards fighting, verbal abuse, and bullying.
3. Use of foul language will not be permitted.
4. Students will be held responsible for damaging school property.
5. Students should dress neatly and appropriately. Refer to our dress code.

7. Students will respect one another.
8. Candy or gum chewing is not permitted.

Dress Code

Clothing/items not permitted

1. Clothing or jewelry with markings of tobacco, drugs, alcohol, or weapons.
2. Clothing or jewelry that conveys messages of nudity, profanity, bias, violence, and/or poses a physical danger.
3. Footwear should not interfere with student's ability to walk safely. (flip flops, high platform shoes.)
4. Shorts and skirts must be worn to the knee.
5. Torn, transparent (see-through), and fishnet clothing. Clothing that exposes undergarments, skin, bare midriffs, or low cut blouses/tops.
6. Gang related clothing or accessories, including but not limited to wearing rosary beads or colored beads, bandanas and doo rags.
