The Delone PTO is comprised of both parents and faculty members. We meet for about an hour the second Monday of every month, August through May in the faculty lunch room beside the cafeteria. Our officers and committee chairs are set for the 2018-2019 school year and monthly attendance is most definitely not required. There are other opportunities throughout the year in which you can be involved – as little, or as much, as your schedule allows.

Our main fundraiser is the Christmas raffle where we raise approximately \$6,000 annually. In addition, we are able to raise funds through the used uniform sale. These sales occur primarily at the Delone carnival held in June and at the freshmen parent orientation in August. Monies raised have helped purchase additional items that exceed the school budget allotment. In the past it has also included lab equipment, part of the sound system in the old gym, and most recently, the water bottle/fountain machine located in the guidance department hallway.
