NYC SCHOOLS ACCOUNT (OVERVIEW)

In 2015, the NYC Department of Education (NYCDOE) launched a new way to access key information about your child's progress in school. With an NYC Schools Account, you can view your child's attendance, grades, assessments, and contact information in one of ten languages on a computer, phone, or tablet. How do I create an NYC Schools Account? You must be your child's parent or legal guardian and live at the same address to create an account. If you have more than one child attending an NYC public school, all children may be linked to the same NYC Schools Account. You can register for an NYC Schools Account one of two ways: • Visit your child's school in-person to receive a temporary password; OR • Use the Account Creation Code provided in the letter from your child's school.
