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Teaching Tips:

- Fold an 8½" x 11" paper in half, hamburger fold. .
- On the front, and glue the map and the label found on the next page, cutting the Virginia map out on the solid line.
- Lift the "map flap" and glue the descriptions listed above inside the foldable.
- Have students color code the regions/groups. Choose colors to color code the regions on the map to match a colored border on the inside flap.
- Students can add more details about each settlement area or draw pictures to aid memory. For details, refer to the Curriculum Framework, page 17.
- Teachers may choose to have students write the information under the flaps rather than use the pre-printed rectangles.

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Glue this map and label to the front of the foldable. Glue the label at the top or bottom of the map.
