


Low woodwind and low brass instruments are very large, expensive instruments that are provided by the school. Examples are Bass Clarinet, Tenor Sax, Baritone Sax, Baritone Horn, and Tuba. The students who play those usually have started on one of the five basic beginner instruments: flute, clarinet, alto sax, trumpet, and trombone. A Clarinet student will be moved to bass clarinet, an alto sax student will be moved to tenor or bari, a trumpet or trombone player will be moved to baritone horn or tuba.

Music & Arts is the company that rents instruments, and their rental program is a rent-to-own plan. An example of their rental plan is listed below for you to review.

Please do not purchase or rent band instruments until after school starts and you are sure that band fits into your child's schedule!

SAMPLE RENT-TO-OWN PLAN: this rate is based upon the 2018-19 school year.

Rent-To-Own Plan

Insure your child's success with a high quality, educator approved instrument. Rent first until commitment and ability have been proven.

There is no obligation to buy. The Rent-To-Own plan provides 3 risk-free options:

1. Rent the instrument until it is purchased. 100% of all rental payments apply to the purchase price.
2. Return at any time with no obligation or exchange to another type of instrument if needed.
3. Purchase at any time and receive a 30% discount off the unpaid balance.

Flute, Clarinet, Trumpet, Trombone, Percussion, Violin, Viola	\$19.99 (plus \$20.97 LDW)	\$29.99 + \$6.99(LDW) = \$36.98

Please complete the 6 Steps on the Rent-To-Own Agreement before seeing the Music & Arts Representative

Step 1: Check the type of instrument your child will be playing. If violin, viola or cello, circle the correct size (see teacher for size).

Step 2: Security on the rental is required. Check the type of security you wish to provide. You may choose one of two options.
Option 1 - Credit or Visa bank debit card. We set up all M&A rentals with our EZ PAY method for making monthly payments
OR, if you do not have a credit card or bank debit card that you wish to use for security & payment
Option 2 - You may provide a refundable security deposit of \$125 for Group A instruments; \$225 for Group B or C.

Step 3: Check **Yes or No** for the LDW Coverage. LDW coverage is optional, but recommended. If your instrument experiences any accidental damage, it will be repaired at no additional charge under LDW. Your instrument is also covered if damaged by fire, or stolen from a secured location. Please note that **LDW coverage may not be added later. Your signature is required regardless of your choice.** The monthly LDW fee is \$6.99 for Group A instruments, \$7.99 for Group B or \$10.99 for Group C.

Step 4: Complete the requested information. Note: **School Name** is the school where your child will be taking music. **School District** is the school system.

Step 5: Complete the credit card or Visa bank debit card information and sign at **Authorized Signature** if:
A. You select the EZ PAY method for your monthly payments. If so, also **initial** the EZ Pay box. *Please note that if you do not select EZ PAY, you will be charged a \$1.50 monthly statement fee and deposit.*
B. You are making the initial payment (step 6) with your credit or debit card.

Step 6: This section will be covered by the Music & Arts Educational Representative.

Finally: Sign, date and print your name at the bottom of the Rent-To-Own agreement.

Take the completed Rent-To-Own Agreement to the Music & Arts Representative for completion. Any questions you may have will be answered.
