### N.B. Clements Crime Prevention

At N.B. Clements Junior High School, we have crime prevention methods in place. The first prevention method is the presence of those who are here to protect us. Two individuals are present at all times, Mr. Walker who is the school security officer, and Officer Jones who is the school resource officer. Both of these men are available to talk to if you see anything suspicious. They will listen to your information and take appropriate action to deal with the person(s) in question. If you see anything, tell them. If you wish to remain anonymous and you still want to report something, there is a program called P3 tips you can use. This program allows anyone to send anonymous tips and information to the Hopewell/Prince George Crime Solvers organization. They, in turn, will send it to the local law enforcement, who will then take appropriate measures to deal with the report. To report something, you can download the P3 Tips app, or you can call the local hotline. The Prince George Hotline is 804-733-2777. You can call or text to send your tip through, and remain completely anonymous. Anything can be reported; it does not have to be something at school. If you see anything, regardless of the severity of the crime, it should be reported. These are the methods Prince George County schools has in place to protect its students, and they should be used to the full extent.
