Dear Parents/Guardians:

You have opted for a full remote learning experience for your child. The NYCDOE has outlined the following expectations for 100% remote learning:

- Students participate in a regular schedule of age appropriate, standards-based remote learning from home every day.
- Students will have live interaction with teachers every day.
- Every class will include live instruction. The amount will vary by grade, depending on what is developmentally appropriate.
- Students will use a DOE-approved online platform Google Classroom available in multiple languages, for lessons and submission of work.
- Students will experience whole class, small group and/or individualized instruction in an online environment, as well as collaboration with classmates and teachers.
- There will be an emphasis on social-emotional learning across school communities to ensure the mental health and wellness of students and staff. (RULER, Mood Meter Check In- How are you feeling today and why?)
- Students will be able to access video-recorded lessons, assignments, and tasks.
- Teachers will regularly engage students and families to check student work, provide timely feedback, and adjust instruction as necessary, via remote learning platforms, calls, emails, video chats, etc.
- Students and families will have access to one-on-one support to help with instructional activities via Office Hours

The following schedule has been designed to maximize the instructional time for your child. All students are expected to be engaged in daily learning for 5.5 hours. All instruction must be delivered within the confines of a typical school day. Under contractual expectations, K- 4 teachers work within the **8:30 a.m. – 2:20 p.m. timeframe; Grades 5-8 teachers work within 8:45 a.m. - 2:35 p.m.**
