Dear Mount Pleasant Cottage School Community:

The district has learned another member of the Mount Pleasant Cottage School UFSD community has tested positive for COVID-19. As a reminder the district has transitioned to remote learning until December 14th.

Upon learning of the positive COVID-19 case, the administration began immediate contact tracing. Given the timeline provided in addition to the fact that this person has not been in the district for two weeks there have been no identified contacts.

We are currently working closely with the Westchester County Department of Health to ensure that no members of the community are considered contacts. The school district will reach out to you directly from 914-227-8890 if you are determined to be a contact.

Please note that The Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) and other privacy laws restrict us from disclosing or confirming any personally identifiable information. We cannot identify anyone who has tested positive. This message is not meant to alarm you. We know it is important to keep you informed during these uncertain times while also respecting the federal and state laws that prohibit the release of confidential medical information.
