Dear Parents and Guardians:

The Mount Pleasant Cottage School Task Force is diligently planning for a safe re-entry to school for Fall 2020. In an effort to aggressively slow the spread of COVID-19, the district is following the New York State Department of Health guidance.

Currently, we are expecting to deliver instruction through a hybrid model in September. The expected model includes four days of in-person instruction and one day of remote learning per week for elementary and alternatively assessed students and for all other students the expected model includes two days of in-person instruction and three days of remote learning per week. Please note if you do not sign and return the form, your child will participate in the hybrid model of both in person and virtual learning.
