

The Town of Dalton is located in central part of Berkshire County in Western Massachusetts. Its population is just under 7,000 residents. The town is largely residential but is also home to Crane Co., formerly Crane and Co., one of the nation's oldest manufacturers and the sole supplier of paper for U.S. currency since 1879. The town offers a wide variety of recreational activities and is centrally located to several cultural venues. The median home value in Dalton is \$185,000 and the average commute for people in Berkshire County is 20 minutes. The main reasons why people work and relocate to the Berkshires are affordability, work/life balance, and its natural, cultural, recreational attractions.
