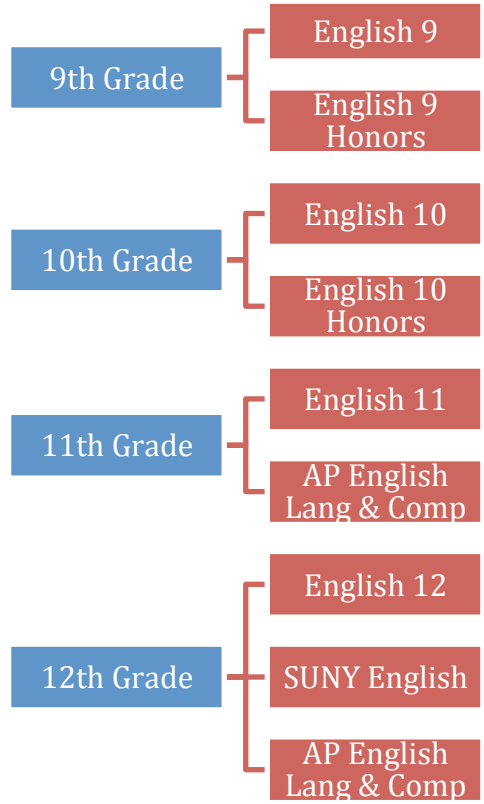


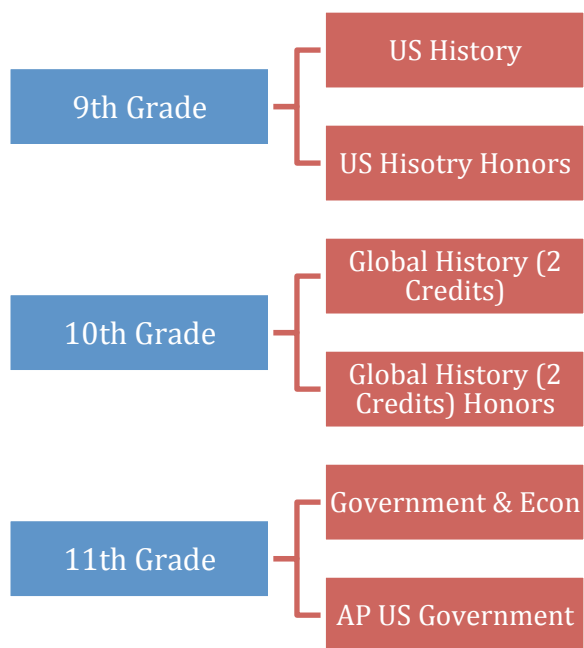

Typical Course Sequence

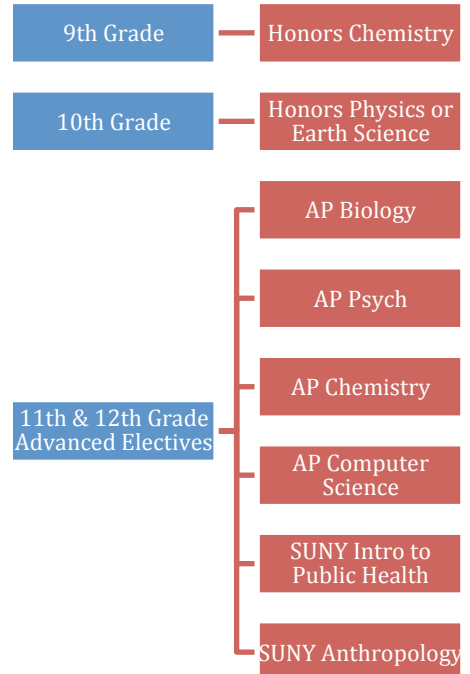
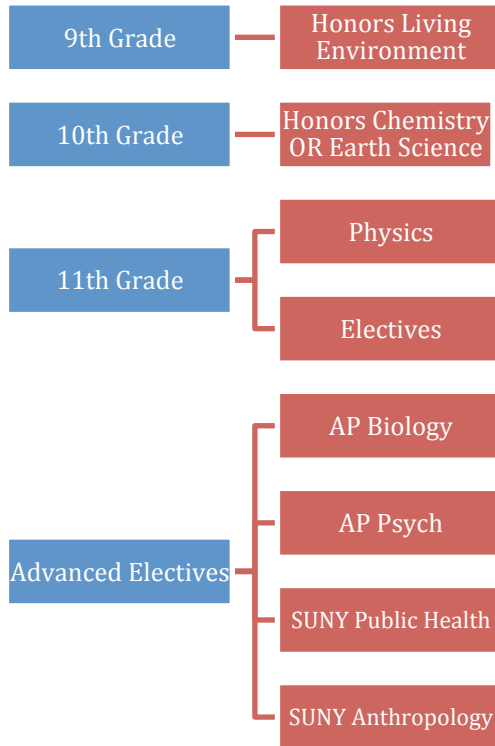
Students with credit for US History in the 8th Grade will take Global History in 9th grade.

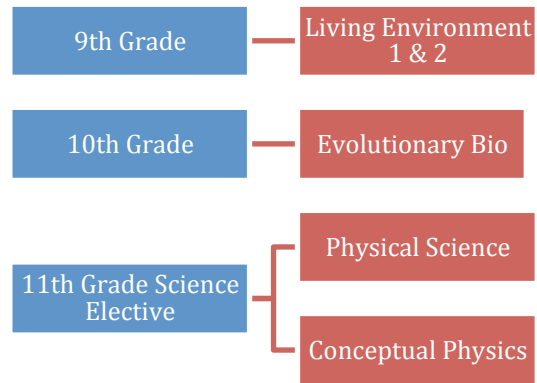
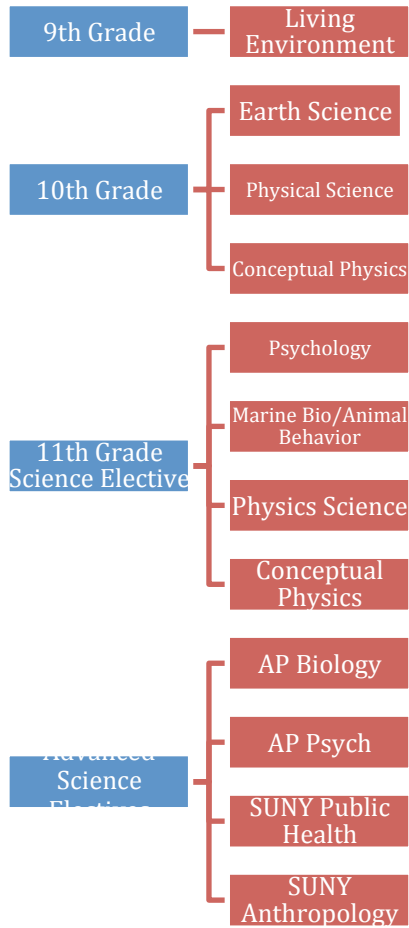

3 Years of Science and one Science Regents is required for the NYS Regents Diploma.

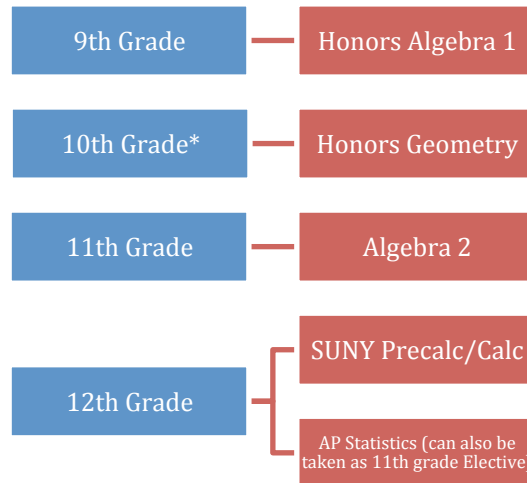

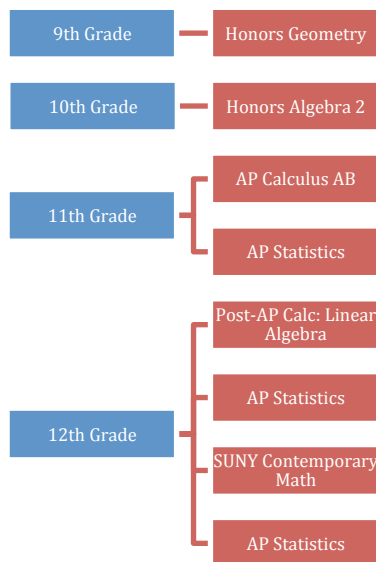

Course Sequence For Honors Students with no previous Math Regents

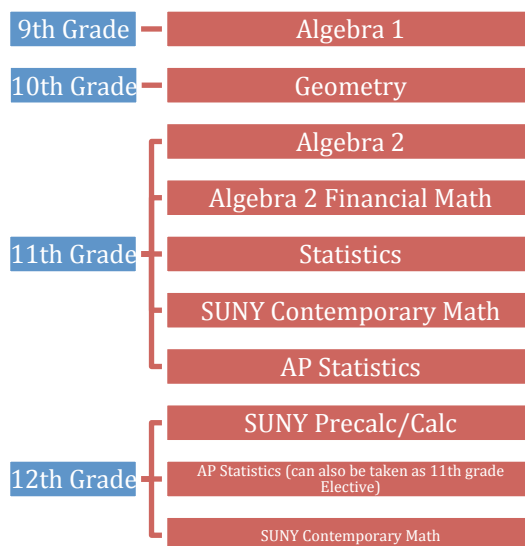
