Dear Junior:

Welcome to your junior year of High School. Hopefully you are looking forward to a wonderful and rewarding year. This year offers many challenges including preparing for the college application process.

A limited number of parking spaces are available for juniors to park on campus. Over the past years, availability of spaces have decreased for juniors as the number of seniors parking has increased. Receiving a driver license is not permission to park on campus. In order to be eligible to park on school grounds you must be in good standing, adhere to the basic rules outlined in the Student Handbook, have school obligations settled (i.e. books returned from previous years) and attend a 'Safe Driving' seminar at Pearl River High School conducted by a high school administrator and Orangetown police officer. Providing the availability of spaces eligible students will be issued a parking sticker with a number provided they have copies of the following: valid driver license, car registration and proof of insurance. If eligible, you may park your vehicle on school grounds in the designated yellow parking spaces reserved for students.

Students may not drive off campus or visit their car during the day. Once vehicles are parked in the morning, they remain parked for the remainder of the school day unless there is a pre-approved PRHS Administration reason (doctor's appointment, release time, etc.) During large community events, such as voting, juniors may not park on campus until after the conclusion of the school day. Parking lot infractions may result in the suspension of parking privileges during a period of time as determined by administration.

If you would like to apply to park on school grounds, you must complete both sides of the enclosed **Parking Application** and return it to Ms. Fran Spina along with **copies of your driver license, car registration and proof of insurance**. Only students with approved parking stickers may park on campus. The [parking application](#) is available on the school website.
