

Dear Parents, Staff, and Students,

On May 24, 2018, we are proud to announce that Mr. Alan Moskin, a World War II veteran and a “Concentration Camp” liberator will be presenting at Pearl River High School. Mr. Moskin served in the United States Army from September 1944 until August 1946. He served as a member of the 66th Infantry, 71st, Division, part of General George Patton’s 3rd Army. While serving, he fought combat in France, Germany and Austria. At the beginning of May 1945, his Company participated in the liberation of the Gunskirchen Concentration Camp, a subcamp of Mauthausen in Austria.

Mr. Moskin will be presenting to the 8th and 9th grade classes and to the 10th through 12th grade classes separately. Each assembly will be about an hour which will include time for questions. The assemblies will be conducted between 10am and 1pm.

He is the 2016 Rockland County Veteran of the Year and has been inducted into the NYS Senate Veterans Hall of Fame. His story has been publicized in “Time” magazine. Mr. Moskin is a current resident of Rockland County. He has spoken to a number of local schools within the county as well as across the country. We are very lucky our students will have this unique opportunity to hear a firsthand account of Mr. Moskin’s World War 2 service to the country.
