## IMPORTANT REMINDERS FOR THE SAT SCHEDULED FOR SATURDAY, OCTOBER 6<sup>TH</sup>

**If you are registered to take an SAT or Subject Test on Saturday, OCTOBER 6<sup>TH</sup> at Pearl River High School please pay close attention to the following reminders:**

1. Plan to arrive to PRHS at 7:45 a.m. and enter through the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor entrance by the flagpole.
2. Bring your admission ticket, acceptable photo identification, acceptable calculator, and sharpened #2 pencils. If you plan to use your school I.D. card as a form of photo identification please be sure it for the **2017-2018 school year ONLY**. You will not be admitted into the test center if you bring an expired school I.D. card.
3. Snacks and drinks are permitted during scheduled breaks only.
4. All cell phones and electronics that are brought to the test center will be collected for the entire exam. Failure to turn your device in can result in your score being cancelled.

**Attention 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> Graders** There are still a limited number of tests available to take the PSAT/NMSQT here at Pearl River HS on October 13. There is a \$30 fee (cash or check made payable to "Pearl River High School") that must be brought to the guidance department as soon as possible.
