## **IMPORTANT REMINDERS FOR THE SAT SCHEDULED FOR SATURDAY, OCTOBER 6<sup>TH</sup>**

**If you are registered to take an SAT or Subject Test on Saturday, OCTOBER 6<sup>TH</sup> at Pearl River High School please pay close attention to the following reminders:**

1. Plan to arrive to PRHS at 7:45 a.m. and enter through the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor entrance by the flagpole.
2. Bring your admission ticket, acceptable photo identification, acceptable calculator, and sharpened #2 pencils. If you plan to use your school I.D. card as a form of photo identification please be sure it for the **2017-2018 school year ONLY**. You will not be admitted into the test center if you bring an expired school I.D. card.
3. Snacks and drinks are permitted during scheduled breaks only.
4. All cell phones and electronics that are brought to the test center will be collected for the entire exam. Failure to turn your device in can result in your score being cancelled.

## **Seniors Parking on Campus**

- 1) Only seniors with approved parking stickers may park on campus. Please register your vehicle with Ms. Fran Spina as all students parking must have an approved 2018-2019 sticker on their vehicle today, Tuesday, October 2.
- 2) Driving on campus: Please review the board policy 5163 regarding driving and parking on campus as students may only drive off campus with an approved pass:

## **5163 HIGH SCHOOL LUNCH PERIODS**

To maintain student focus during the school day on educational program activities, high school students shall be required to eat lunch at school and remain on the school **campus** during their lunch period with the exception of seniors, who shall enjoy the privilege of walking **off** school grounds for lunch. Students who **drive** cars to school, regardless of where they park, are prohibited from using their cars during the hours of the school day,

unless they are in possession of a school approved dismissal pass issued by the Building Principal, based upon a written application by the student's parent, legal guardian or the student's own note where the student is an emancipated minor or has reached the age of 21.
