Junior Year Timeline

September: Don't worry about registering for your PSATs. All juniors will take it!
For Free!!!!

October: Take the PSAT October 11, 2017 during the school day.

November: Create a CollegeBoard account if you haven't already.

December: Receive PSAT scores via email or in your CollegeBoard account.
Make an appointment to review your scores (among other things!)
with your counselor in January.

January: Attend Annual College Alumni Panel hosted by the School Counseling
Office. Appointment with your counselor to:

- Review PSAT scores.
- Plan SAT, Subject Test, and ACT testing schedule.
- Begin preliminary college search.

February: Register for spring SATs, Subject tests, and ACTs.

Consider prep course (online or our own after school class).

Research colleges with parents and schedule visits.

Course selections for senior year...make wise choices!

March: Counselors' Workshop for parents March 1, 2018 at 6:00PM

Continue to research and visit colleges.

Prep for SATs and ACTs.

April: Continue to research and visit colleges.

May: Attend the 13th Annual Eastern Dutchess College Fair during the school day in our gym on May 3rd.
