Students in 11th and 12th grades may be inducted into the Pawling High School chapter of the National Honor Society. There are several steps in the induction process. First, students must be deemed academically eligible to receive an honor society application. To be academically eligible, a student must be a junior or senior with a 90.00 GPA or better. If a student meets this academic criterion, he or she will be given an application packet. This packet is available online, and must be electronically submitted.

The application packet assesses a student's level of achievement regarding the four qualities an honor society member must embody: scholarship, leadership, character, and service. In order to best gauge student achievement, the application packet requires students to detail their extra-curricular activities, leadership positions, service activities, and any other community involvement. A five-member faculty council will review applications and award membership. Students will be notified of their application status within three weeks of submission. There will be an induction ceremony held at the end of October. Upon induction, students are expected to continue to demonstrate the qualities of outstanding scholarship, character, leadership and service.
