## **INTERSCHOLASTIC ATHLETICS**

### **Course Credit**

In accordance with existing Regulations of the Commissioner of Education, the Board of Education will permit students in grades 11-12 to receive credit towards high school graduation equivalent to physical education for participation in interscholastic athletics. These students must play three varsity level sports to be considered for this privilege. Such credit will, in addition to other requirements, be contingent upon proven cardiovascular and physical fitness and competency in lifetime or carry-over sports. Standards for such fitness and competency shall be developed by the administration.
