PURPOSE

The purpose of this organization is to promote scholarship in, and enjoyment and understanding of, mathematics among high school (or two-year college) students.

SELECTION OF MEMBERS

Students who have achieved a score of at least 90 in each of the Algebra, Geometry, and Algebra II courses shall be considered for membership.

Prior to selection, students will be required to produce a written statement on a mathematics topic provided. A panel of mathematics teachers will review applications and determine if candidates have met the requirements for membership.

The induction ceremony for Pawling High School's chapter is held during the spring semester.

MEMBERS' DUTIES

Members will attend regularly scheduled meetings.

Members participate in Mu Alpha Theta projects.

Members will earn a minimum of five hours per semester of club-related community service as deemed appropriate by the chapter advisor.

DISCIPLINE AND DISMISSAL

Members who fail to adhere to the Pawling High School code of conduct as written in the Student Handbook may be dismissed from the chapter.
