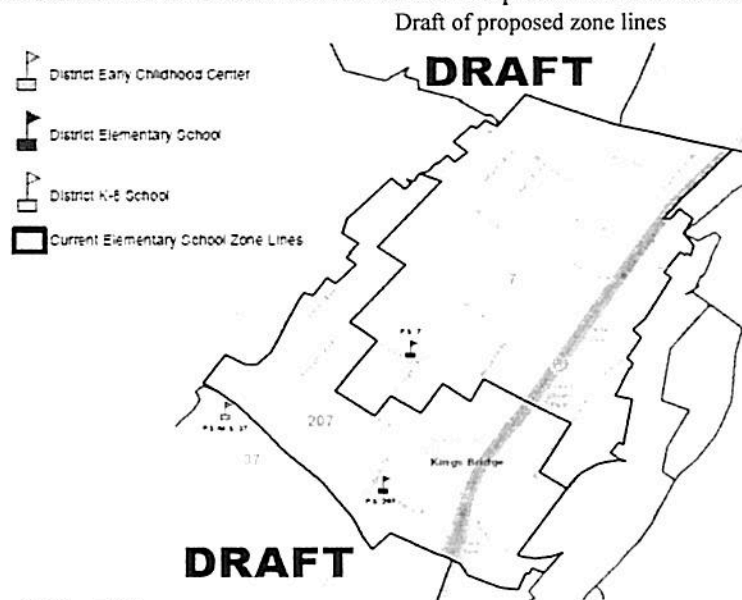


Kingsbridge Rezoning Draft Map Presentation
September 20th, 6:00 PM at P.S. 91
2200 Aqueduct Avenue, Bronx, NY 10453

Overview:

- P.S. 207 (10X207) is currently in year one of its grade expansion from serving pre-K-2 to serving pre-K-5. P.S. 207 serves grades K-3 and pre-K in 2018-2019, and it will serve grades K-4 and pre-K in 2019-2020 and grades K-5 and pre-K in 2020-2021 and beyond.
- Currently P.S. 207 and P.S. 7 (10X007) share a zone.
- The NYCDOE's Office of District Planning (ODP) is working with District 10 Superintendent Maribel Torres-Hulla, in collaboration with the District 10 Community Education Council (CEC), to develop a rezoning proposal that would split the school zone that P.S. 7 and P.S. 207 currently share.
- If approved by the CEC, the proposal will create distinct zones that will allow for all students to have a distinct zoned school which is clear to families and help each school maintain a stable enrollment.



Zoning Process and Next Steps

- Though zones may change if the rezoning is approved by the CEC, all currently enrolled students may remain in their schools until graduation.
- The rezoning, if approved, would go into effect for students entering either school in September 2019 and would only impact incoming and new students.
- ODP presented at the April and June 2018 CEC meetings to keep the community apprised of the planning process and potential rezoning.
- Superintendent Torres-Hulla and ODP will present a draft of the rezoning proposal at the public CEC 10 meeting on September 20th at 6:00 PM. The meeting will be held at P.S. 91: 2200 Aqueduct Avenue, Bronx, NY 10453.
- The final zone line proposal will be presented at the October 18th CEC meeting at P.S. 8: 3010 Briggs Ave, Bronx, NY 10458. The CEC is anticipated to vote on the proposal at the October 18th meeting.
