### SUMMARY: 2017 Milestones

The scores provided are official D.A.T.E. Milestone's Testing, prior to retesting, recorded from Georgia Department of Education. This comprehensive assessment system measures how well students have learned the knowledge and skills outlined in the state-adopted content standards for English Language Arts, Mathematics, Science (Grades 5 and 8), and Social Studies (Grades 5 and 8). Students in grades 3 through 8 took an End-of-Grade (EOG) assessment, while high school students took an End-of-Course (EOC) assessment for courses designated by the State Board of Education.

## MILESTONE'S DESCRIPTION OF LEVELS

There are four stages that measures students' levels of learning:

Beginning Learner: Student does not yet demonstrate proficiency.

These students need substantial academic support to be prepared for the next grade.

(When these assessments are used to determine promotion, students in this level will not be promoted to the next grade.)

**Developing Learner:** Student demonstrates partial proficiency. These students need additional academic support to ensure success in the next grade.

**Proficient Learner:** Student demonstrates proficiency. These students are prepared for the next grade level and are considered to be on track for college and career readiness.

**Distinguished Learner:** Student demonstrates advanced proficiency. Students are well prepared for the next grade level.

## SUMMARY OF PERFORMANCES

# D.A.T.E comparisons with State and District on: Developing and Above (Proficient and Distinguished) Levels

In English and Math in grades 3-8, D.A.T.E. outperformed the district and the state, with the exception of third grade scoring below the state in math by 6 % points. In science and social studies, on average D.A.T.E. outperformed the district and the state, but fail to surpass the state in 8<sup>th</sup> grade science by 14 points. In comparison to all district level tests for grades 3rd - 8th grades, and average point increases; D.A.T.E. surpassed the district in English by 23 points, math by 22 points, social studies by 11 points, and science by 12 points. In comparison to state level tests for grades 3rd -8th and average points increases, D.A.T.E. surpassed the state in English by 11 points, math by 8 points. D.A.T.E. did not surpass the state in science by 7 points and social studies by 1 point for 5<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grades.




