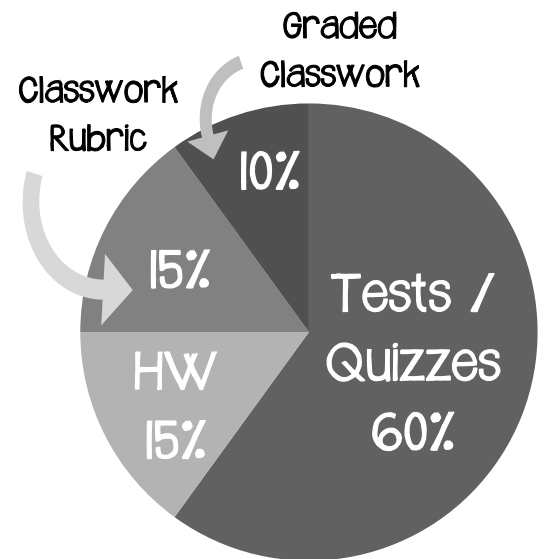



EXTRA HELP

OTHER INFORMATION:

- We will be preparing for the sixth grade **New York State Mathematics Assessment**, which is scheduled for **April 21st - 23rd** (only two days will be used for administration of the assessment; specific dates TBA).
- Assignments should be dated and kept in students' math binders **in date order** so that it is easier for students to locate all materials that relate to certain topics within each unit.
- The **classwork rubric** will be completed quarterly. This rubric encompasses participation in whole class discussions, participation in small group discussions, completion of independent tasks, preparedness, daily classwork, attentiveness, behavior, and commitment to learning.
- Students will be given **review packets** for extra practice and continuity of learning **during school breaks**. These packets will be distributed a few days prior to each break and will be due a few days after we return to school in order to give those who may be away from home ample time to complete the assignment.

- MP 1  • Unit 1: Multiplying & Dividing (6.NS.1 - 6.NS.4)
- MP 2  • Unit 2: Ratios (6.RP.1 - 6.RP.3)
- MP 3  • Unit 3: Introduction to Rational Numbers (6.NS.5 - 6.NS.8)
- MP 4  • Unit 4: Expressions (6.EE.1 - 6.EE.4)
- MP 5  • Unit 5: Equations (6.EE.5 - 6.EE.9)
- MP 6  • Unit 6: Concepts in Geometry (6.G.1 - 6.G.5)
- MP 7  • Unit 7: Introduction to Statistics (6.SP.1 - 6.SP.8)

Units 1 - 6 will be covered before the state assessment.

HOMEWORK:

- Homework will be **assigned and checked daily**. Homework should be completed **in pencil** with **all work shown**. Homework that isn't completed accordingly will not earn full credit (1 point).
- Missing homework assignments may be submitted after their due date for **half credit** before the end of the marking period. Assignments that are not made up will earn a 0.
- Homework may be **collected and graded**, with or without notice.
