Please PRINT your child's name and class on the check or money order and the words SENIOR DUES on the envelope, in addition to completing the tear-off below. Senior Dues should be given to your child's **HOMEROOM** teacher.

Each graduate will receive **FOUR TICKETS** to graduation (graduates do not need a ticket). Families that need additional tickets (maximum 2 additional) may request the amount on the tear-off below (there are no guarantees).

Please note that students that do meet Department of Education promotional criteria for 8th grade and/or have consistently poor behavioral records can be excluded from the graduation ceremony and/or the Senior Dance.
