- Visit the **Statue of Liberty Museum** - The museum consists of three gallery spaces. Each one is meant to inspire visitors and educate them about the Statue of Liberty in interactive and thought-provoking ways. **The Immersive Theater** is a dramatic, multimedia experience lasting approximately 8-10 minutes that surrounds visitors in the sweeping story of the Statue and the ideals she represents. **The Engagement Gallery** has a series of multimedia displays evoke the feeling of being in the sculptor's studio, allowing guests to see the step-by-step process of Liberty's construction. **The inspiration Gallery** has the tour culminates with an up-close view of Liberty's most iconic symbol – her original torch.
- **The 9/11 Memorial Museum** serves as the country's principal institution concerned with exploring the implications of the events of 9/11, documenting the impact of those events and exploring 9/11's continuing significance. The Museum tells the story of 9/11 through interactive technology, archives, narratives and a collection of artifacts. Enter the Museum through a pavilion located between the two Memorial reflecting pools and gradually descend to the bedrock level of the Museum which contains the remnant foundations of the original World Trade Center.
- **Dinner at Dallas BBQ** – Chicken & Rib Combo – Vegetarian option available.
- **Blue Man Group** Evening Performance - Three enigmatic bald and blue characters take the audience through a multi-sensory experience that combines theater, percussive music, art, science and vaudeville into a form of entertainment that is like nothing else either on or off-Broadway.
- **Visit New-York Historical Society Museum** A trip to New York City won't be complete without a visit to the New-York Historical Society where four centuries of American history comes to life. Students will be divided into groups and participate in one of several hands on educational programs – History Detectives; MEGA Scavenger Hunt that will take place on all 4 floors; and New York Story, a film that you will watch on a surround-sound 75-foot screen. It explores the story of New York and its rise from a remote outpost to a city at the center of the world. You'll see extraordinary treasures and special displays, rare artifacts and powerful images. You will experience where we came from -- and understand better why we are the way we are.
- **American Museum of Natural History** – Buy your lunch at personal expense in the Food Court and browse exhibits.
- **Top Of The Rock Observation Deck at Rockefeller Center:** Unobstructed 360 degree views from the 70th floor offer breathtaking panoramic views of Central Park, the Chrysler Building, Times Square, the Hudson River, the East River, the Brooklyn Bridge, and the Statue of Liberty. Quite simply, it's the most spectacular view in New York City.
- **Madame Tussauds Wax Museum:** There are many reasons for this enduring success, but at the heart of it all is good, old fashioned curiosity. You are sent on a unique journey through the realms of history, power and fame. The museum-style ropes and poles have gone so you can truly get up close and personal with A-list celebrities, sports legends, political heavyweights and historical icons, reliving times, events and moments that made the world talk about them.
